Governor Bill Richardson Appoints New Judge to 4th Judicial District Court

SANTA FE – Today Governor Bill Richardson appointed Gerald E. Baca to fill a new judicial position in the 4th Judicial District Court in San Miguel County.

Mr. Baca has served as the sole practitioner for his own law office for nearly 10 years. Prior to which he worked in the private sector and for the District Attorney's Office. He has practiced juvenile and criminal law, domestic relations and personal injury law. Baca earned a bachelors degree in Political Science from New Mexico Highlands University and obtained his law degree from the University of New Mexico School of Law.
